- Microscopy (e.g., high-plex FISH) and sequencing
- Very diverse analysis methods required due to biotech, chemistry, data formats etc
- R is lagging in handling these large datasets (even a small expt runs into a few TB)
- Python has an excellent framework to deal with spatially aligned datasets and queries
- There was a hackathon (last year?) w/scverse | Vince Carey, Martin Morgan, etc.
 - ScienceServe -- applied for Helmholtz funding
- OSTA -- orchestrating spatial (transcript) omics analysis with Bioconductor
 - Using GH, OSF for data distribution
 - Submitted to Bioconductor
 - Future work will continue working on it
